JOHN 4:28-30

28 Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, 29 "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?"

30 They came out of the town and made their way toward him.

JOHN 4:39-40

39 Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did."

40 So when the Samaritans came to him, they urged him to stay with them, and he stayed two days.

JOHN 4:41-42

41 And because of his words many more became believers. 42 They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."

(A) Encounter with the Lord (v. 7-26, 28a)

- Cost us something
- Changes either immediately or gradually
- > For the Cause of Christ

(B) Experience - sharing (v. 28b-30)

Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?

How to share the Good News?


- * Our condition apart from Christ
- * What Jesus did for us?
- * How we need to repent and trust Jesus?
- * What happen when we do so?

(C) <u>Expansion</u> (v. 39-41)

- 1. Expansion of believers
- 2. Expansion of border
- 3. Expansion deep within her being:
- * enlarge her heart
- * enlarge her mind
- * extend her influence
- * increasing measure
- * by reaching out we 'multiply ourselves' reproduce


(D) Expression of Faith (v. 42)

- * Testimony as a starting point
- * Personal knowledge of Christ
- * Saviour of the world extend His saving reign to the farthest corner of the earth
- * In the context of ministry to Samaritans first // cross-cultural evangelism undertaken by Jesus
