

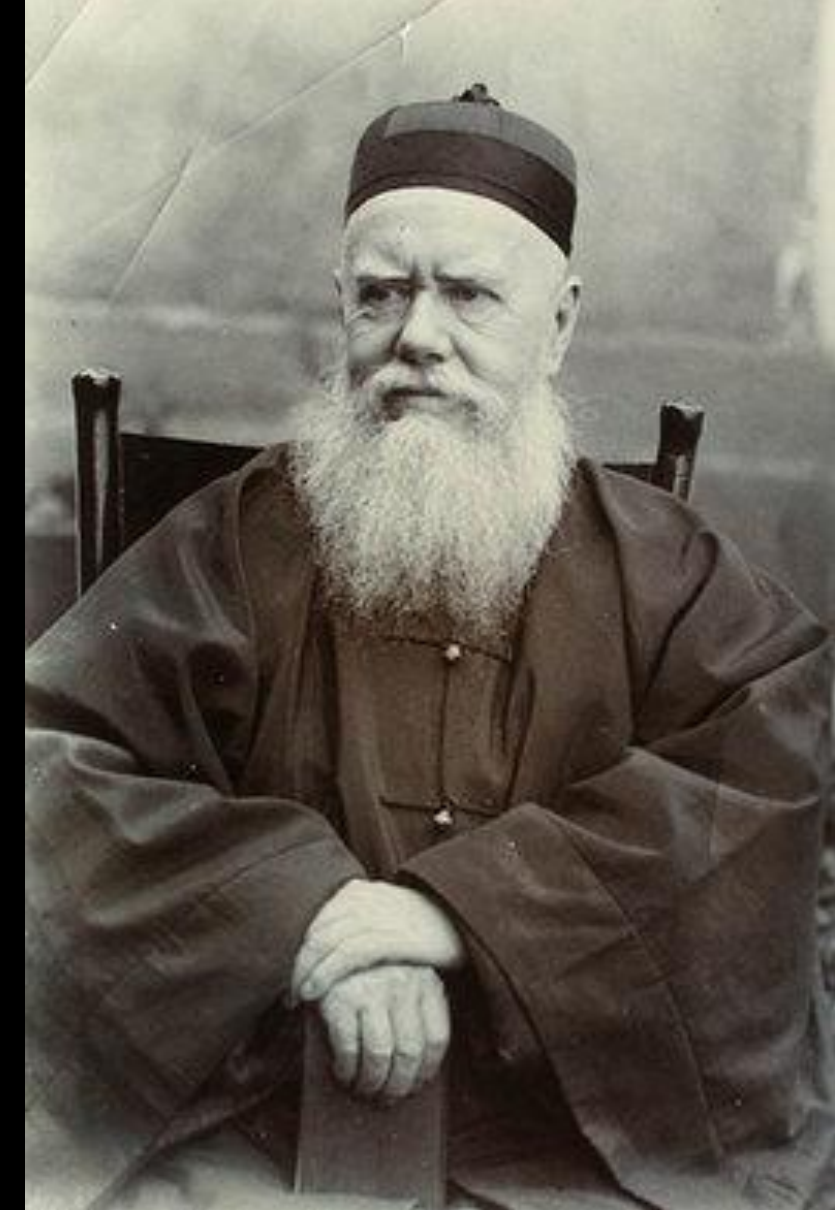
**DISCERNING THE

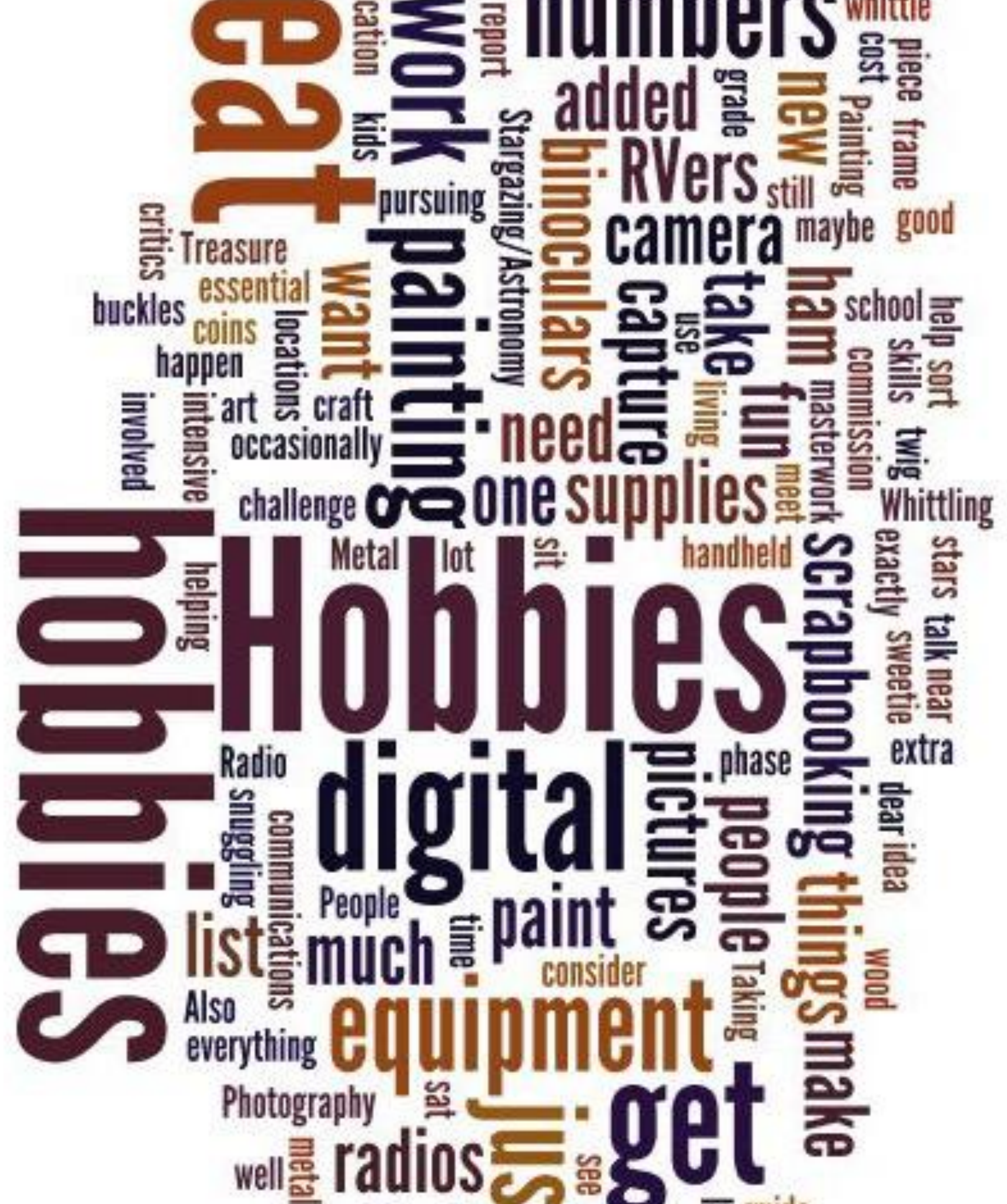

Lord, teach me what you want me to do, and I will obey you with all my heart. I will follow your ways till the very end of my life.





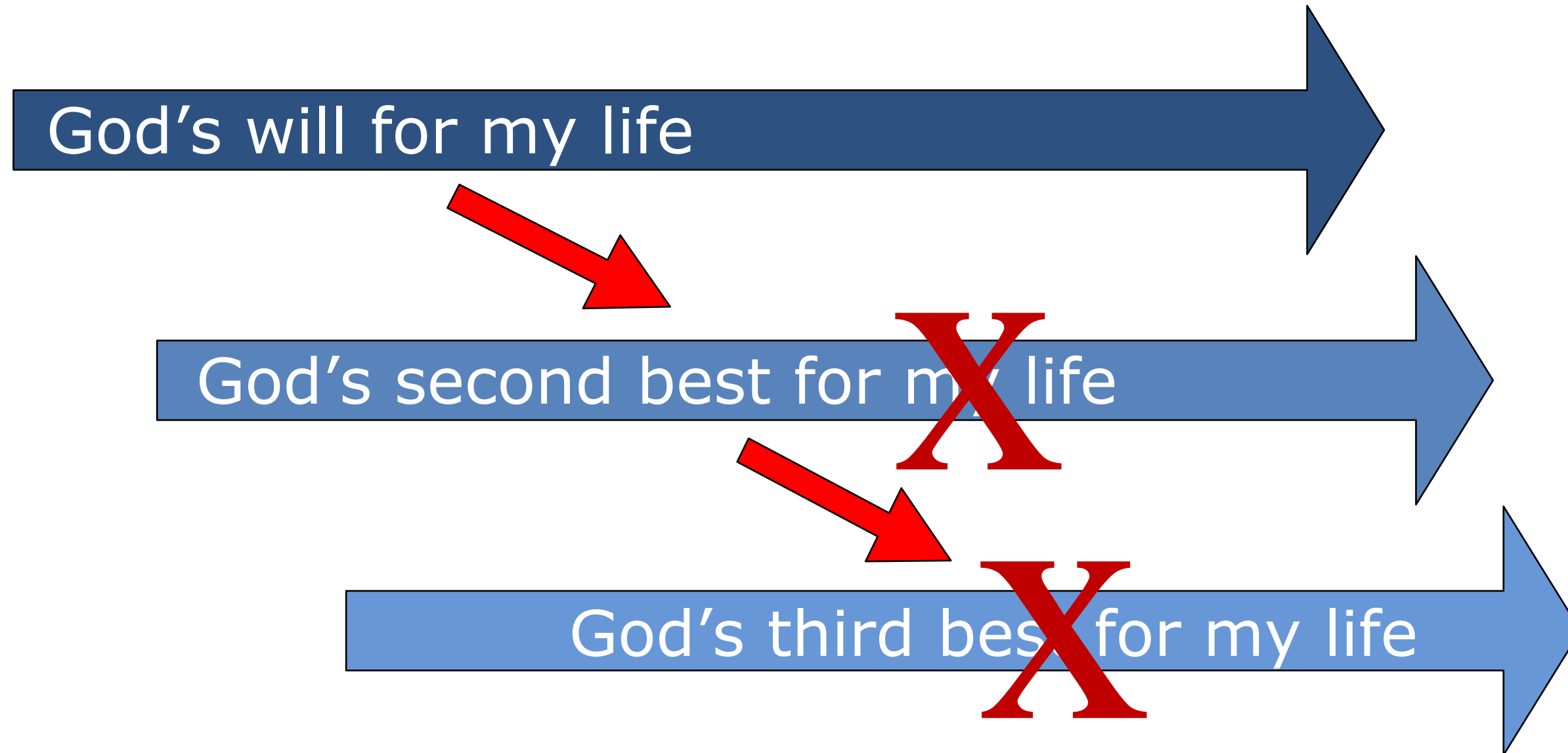
**You may already know about 90% of

**Living life as *I* choose; not bothering to find out God's plans for my life.**

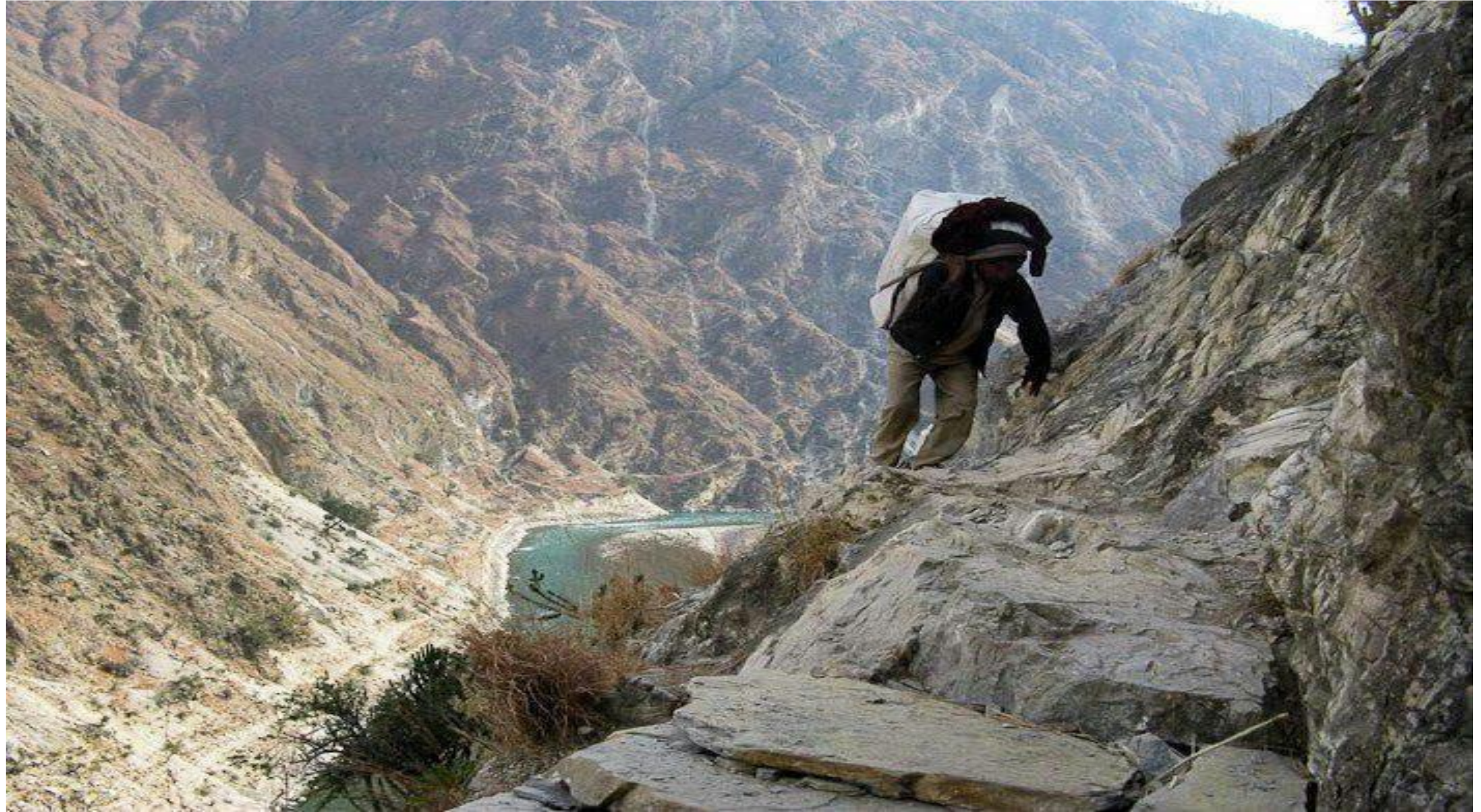
**Making excuses for not doing what God wants me to.**

**Settling for second best; giving up before the end.**

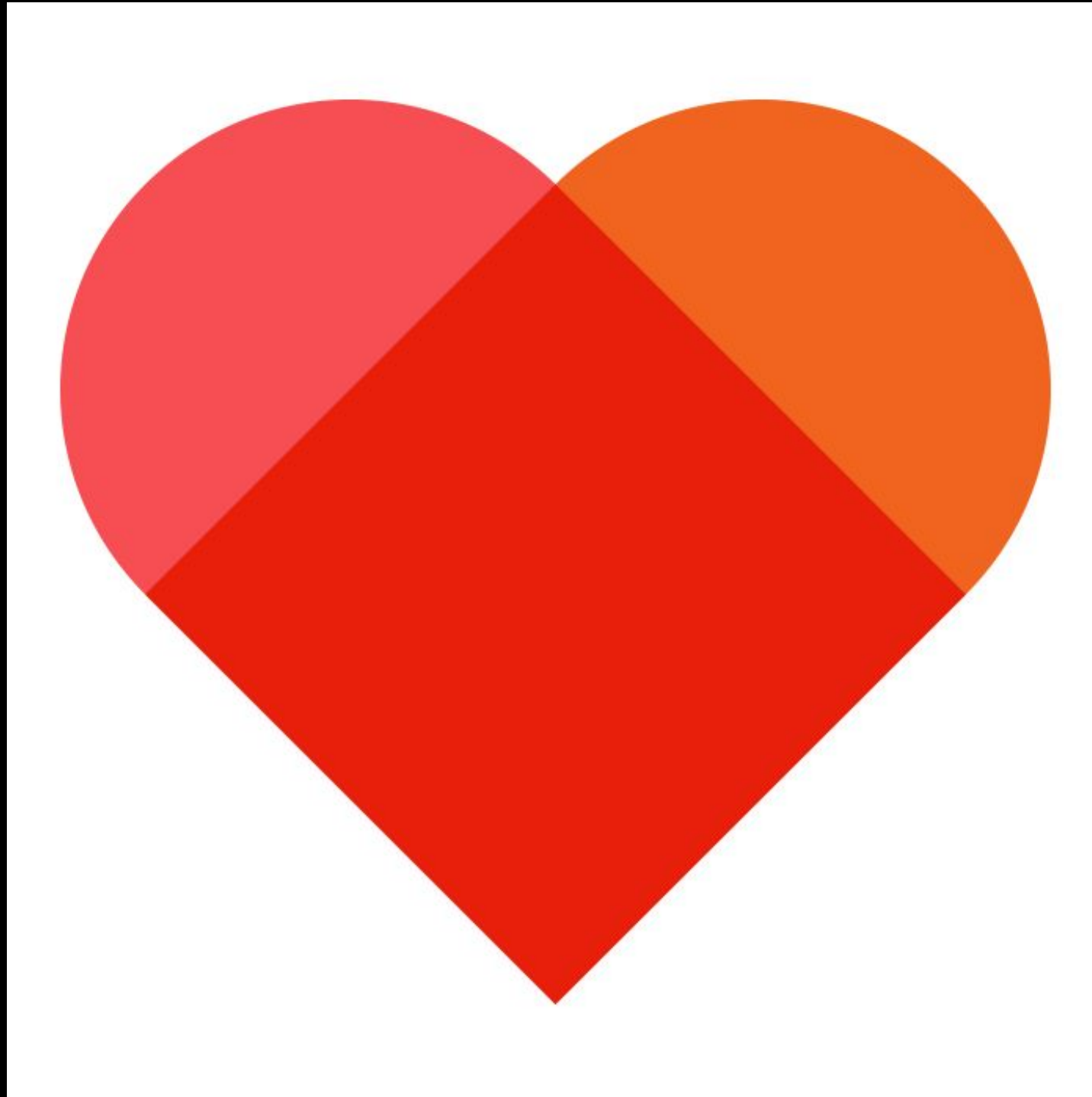
**Trying to do God's will in *my* way instead of His.**
