




# It's Our Choice! (Jeremiah 17:5-9) The Cursed Life or the Blessed Life




### The Cursed Life (Jeremiah 17:5-6)

- A human-centred and human-reliant outlook that tries to create heaven on earth.
- They are bound TO earth because they see themselves solely or predominantly as residents on earth.

### The Blessed Life (Jeremiah 17:7-8)

- A God-centred and Godreliant outlook whereby man taste heaven on earth.
- They are bound FOR heaven and see themselves as citizens of heaven and are now pilgrims on earth.





# What Ultimately Counts and Matters

- What ultimately counts in this life is what ultimately matters on the day or judgement.
- 2 Corinthians 5:10;1 Corinthians 3:12-15

### Fruitfulness In Eternal Righteousness

- The Crown of Righteousness (2 Timothy 4:7–8)
- The Imperishable Crown (1 Corinthians 9:24–27)
- Finishing the race of life with the fruits of righteousness holiness and godliness (1 Peter 1:13-20; Galatians 3:1-5; 5:16-17).




#### Ministering to the Needy – Our Supreme Example

#### Ministering to the Needy – Our Sincere Execution

• Our execution to help those in need with what we have already been given in abundance, spiritually, emotionally, physically (Matthew 25:31-46; 2 Corinthians 1:3-7; 6:4-10; Galatians 2:10; 1 Timothy 6:18-19).


# Our Luggage to Eternity


The only things in this life that we can bring along to eternity are:
