


# Sermon Title Sinners Declared Righteous

#### Keywords

- Justification to make someone right in the eyes of God
- **Propitiation** to satisfy or appease God's wrath
- Faith to trust and obey

#### **God's Rescue Plan**



#### <u>But now</u> the <u>righteousness of God apart from</u> <u>the law</u> is revealed, being <u>witnessed by the</u> <u>Law and the Prophets</u>. (Verse 21)

The righteousness of God, <u>through faith in</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference; (Verse 22)

### Abram believed the LORD, and it was credited to him as righteousness (Genesis 15:6)


<sup>17</sup> By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had embraced the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, <sup>18</sup> even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." <sup>19</sup> Abraham reasoned that God could even raise the dead, and so in a manner of speaking he did receive Isaac back from death. (Hebrews 11:17-19)

# <sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Verses 23)

# being justified freely by His grace through the <u>redemption</u> that is <u>in Christ Jesus</u>, (Verse 24)

### (Jesus) whom <u>God set forth</u> as a <u>propitiation</u> by <u>His</u> <u>blood</u>, <u>through faith</u>, <u>to demonstrate His</u> <u>righteousness</u>, (Verse 25a)

# Only one WAY, one MAN and one SACRIFICE to secure our freedom



(Jesus) whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, <u>because in His forbearance God had</u> <u>passed over the sins that were previously committed</u> (Verse 25b) to demonstrate at the <u>present time</u> His righteousness, that He might be <u>just</u> and the <u>justifier</u> of the one who has faith in Jesus (Verses 26)

#### <sup>27</sup> Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by the law of faith. (Verse 27)

<sup>28</sup> Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith apart from the deeds of the law. <sup>29</sup> Or is He the God of the Jews only? Is He not also the God of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also, <sup>30</sup> since there is one God who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through faith. (Verses 28-30)

#### <sup>31</sup> Do we then make void the law through faith? Certainly not! On the contrary, we establish the law. (Verse 31)
