FEASTS OF WEEKS (SHAVUOT)

PENTECOST

Along with Passover and the Feast of Tabernacles, Shavuot is one of three **Shalosh Regalim**, or **pilgrimage festivals**, during which all Jews were to report to the **Temple in Jerusalem to present offerings to God**. Shavuot is directly connected to Passover.

On the <u>second day of Passover</u>, an omer of grain was to be offered in the Temple, thus officially beginning the <u>Sefirat HaOmer</u> (<u>the</u> <u>counting of the omer</u>).

FEASTS OF WEEKS (SHAVUOT)

PENTECOST

This <u>counting lasts for 49 days or seven weeks</u> and <u>culminates in</u> the <u>festival that commemorates the birth of Israel</u>. Thus, it is also known as the <u>"Feasts of Weeks</u>."

The term **Pentecost** derives from the Greek word meaning **"fifty."**

THE BEGINNING OF THE NATION OF ISRAEL SHAVUOT

On <u>Passover</u>, the Israelites were given <u>freedom from Pharaoh</u>; on <u>Shavuot</u>, they were <u>given the Torah</u>.

When the <u>Jews accepted the Torah</u>, they became servants of God.
The <u>Nation of Israel was born</u>.

THE BEGINNING OF THE CHURCH

PENTECOST

Jesus fulfilled Passover by being the perfect "Lamb of God" who was sacrificed for our deliverance from sin and Satan.

Similarly, after Jesus went up to heaven, <u>the Holy Spirit was given</u> <u>at Pentecost</u>. When the disciples received the gift, they became witnesses for Christ. <u>The church was born</u>.





