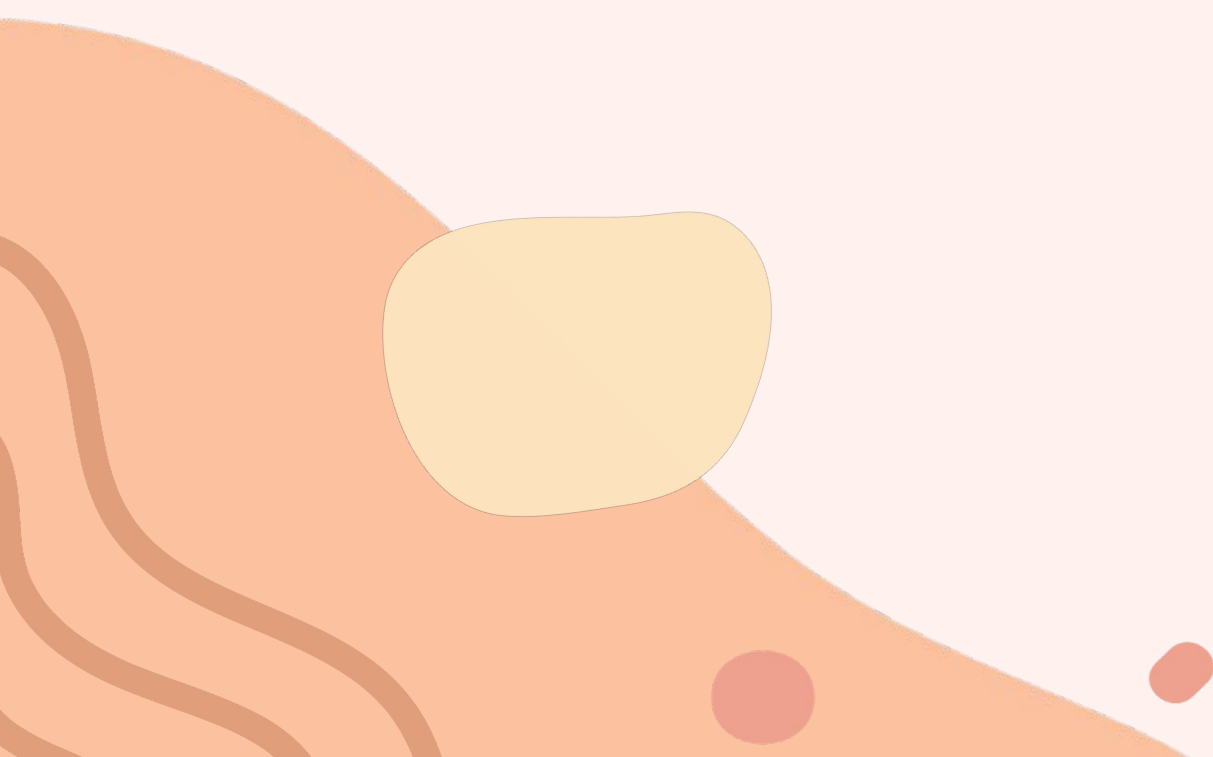
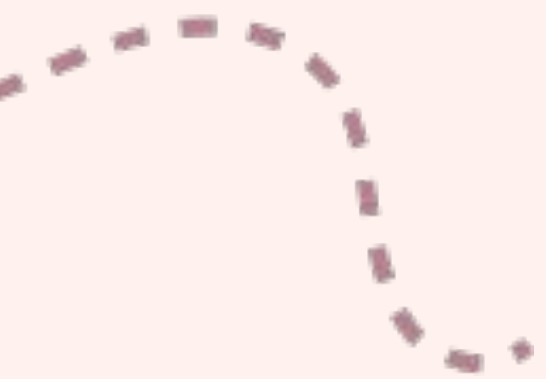
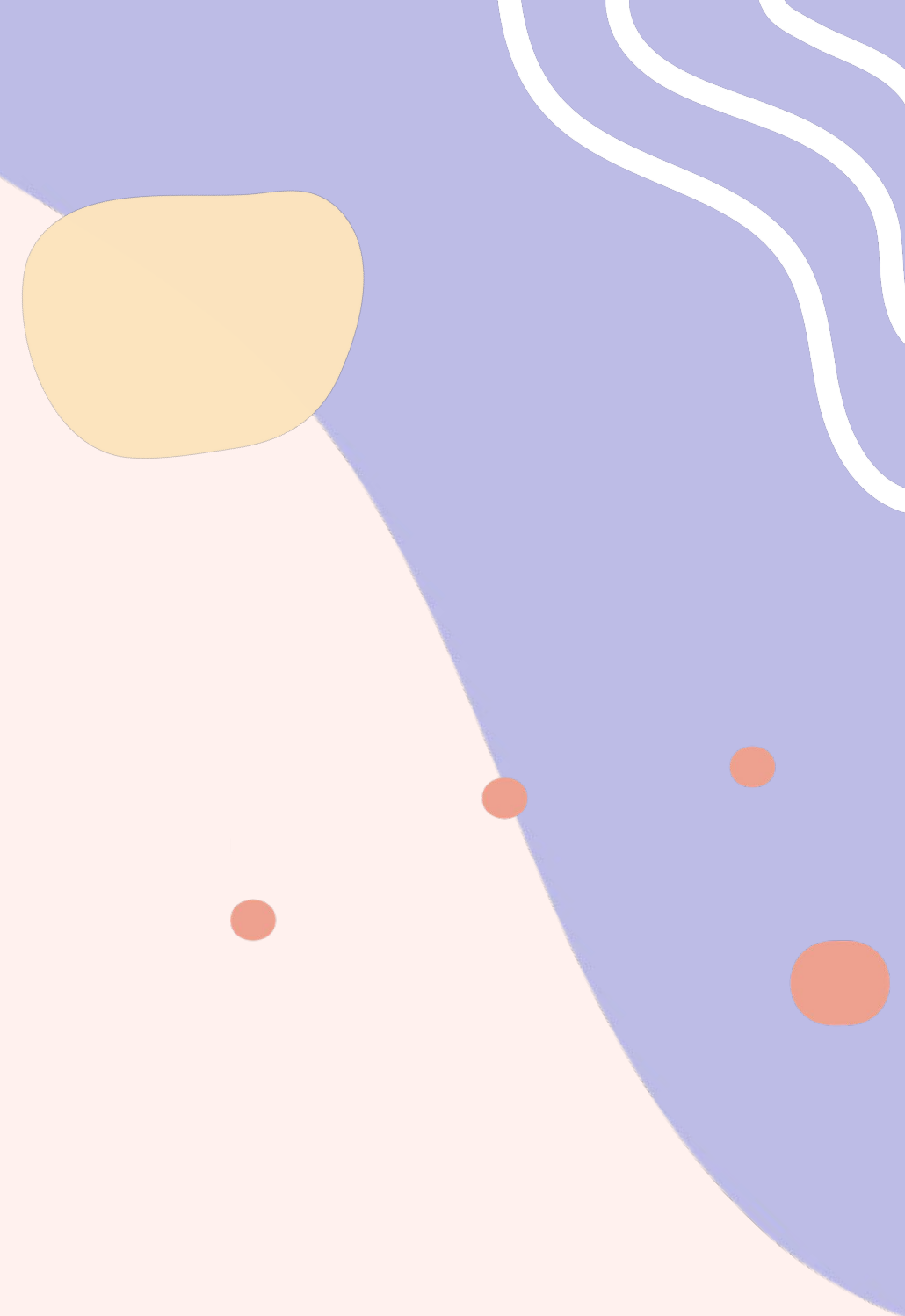
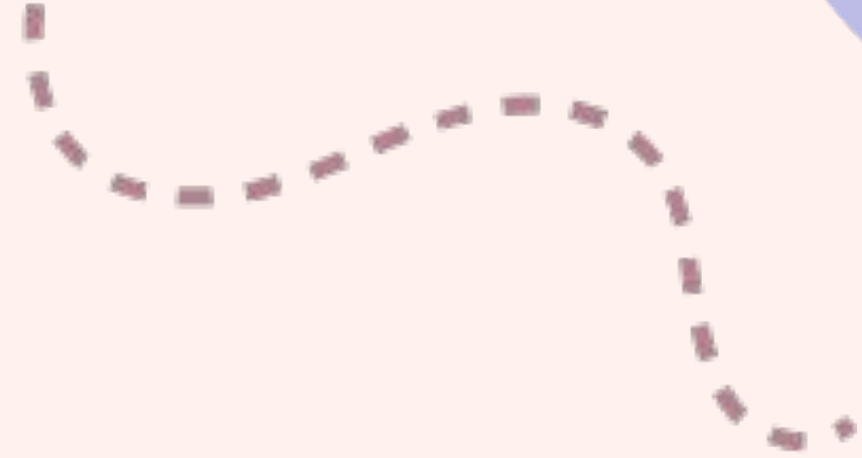
Matthew 18:1-5
