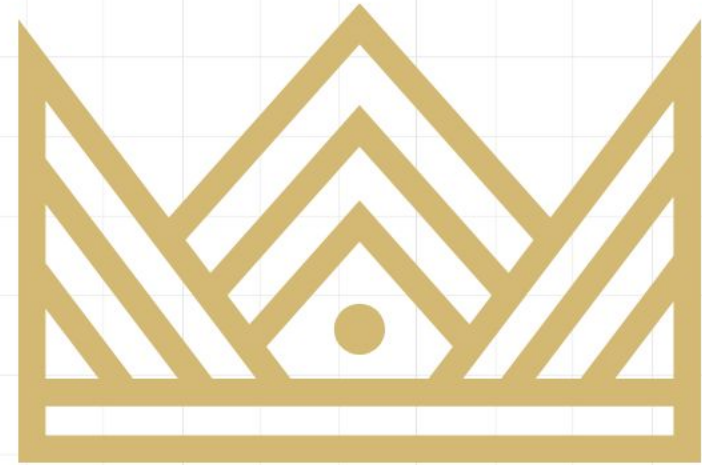




The Lord Swore An Oath To David
