#### Introduction

The oracle that Habakkuk the prophet saw.

O LORD, how long shall I cry for help, and you will not hear? Or cry to you "Violence!" and you will not save? Why do you make me see iniquity, and why do you idly look at wrong? Destruction and violence are before me; strife and contention arise. (Hab 1:1-3)





#### Introduction

Habakkuk complained and questioned God.

How can God allow the Babylonians to destroy Judah?

God assured Habakkuk that the Sovereign God who had worked powerfully in their past is still the Sovereign God of the present and the future.

#### Introduction

Habakkuk responded in chapter 3 and ended with the declaration that no matter what happened, he would rejoice in the Lord and trust in Him.



#### In the Face of Calamities

I heard and my heart pounded, my lips quivered at the sound; decay crept into my bones, and my legs trembled. Yet I will wait patiently for the day of calamity to come on the nation invading us. V16



#### In the Face of Calamities
