


A Beautiful Church

LA SAGRADA FAMILIA





13 Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his mother, who has been a mother to me, too.


14 Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas and the other brothers and sisters with them.


