Al Overview

Intergenerational refers to people of different generations interacting with each other, while multigenerational refers to people of different generations being in the same space.



Intergenerational

- Involves people of different ages working together, sharing, and learning from each other
- Can involve mentoring and smaller service groups
- Can focus on developing disciples and empowering generations to invest in each other
- Can involve creating intentional and interactive settings for generations to come together

Multigenerational

- Involves people of different generations being in the same space, but not necessarily interacting
- Can involve separate churches or worship services for each generation
- Can involve focusing on youth as the future
