John 3:1-4

3 Now there was a Pharisee, a man named **Nicodemus** who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. ² He came to Jesus at night and said, “Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs you are doing if God were not with him.” Jesus replied, “Very truly I tell you, no one can see the **kingdom of God** unless they are born again.” How can someone be born again when they are old? Nicodemus asked. “Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother’s womb to be born!”

John 3:5-10

Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit give birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. Divine Birth

Divine Sight

Divine Life

Summary

1. **A New Birth is Necessary** – To experience God's kingdom, we must be born again (John 3:3).
2. **The Unseen Reality of God's Kingdom** – It's invisible to the world but revealed to those who seek it (Matt. 6:33).
3. **Heaven's Life Starts Now** – We don't have to wait—we can live in God's kingdom *today* (Luke 17:21).
4. **Surrendered Living** – True kingdom life means letting God rule, not ourselves (Matt. 6:10).
